

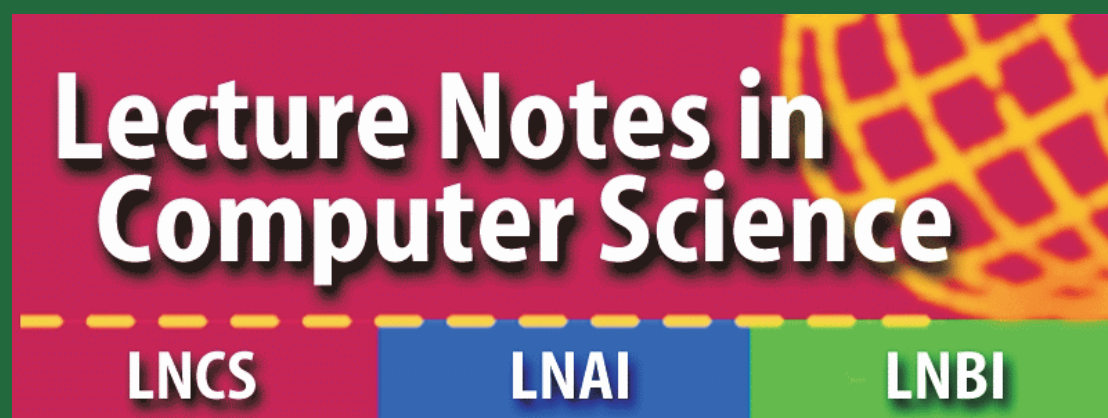
# III BRAZILIAN SYMPOSIUM ON BIOINFORMATICS (BSB)

BSB is a multidisciplinary symposium, which provides a general forum for presentation and discussion of original research on computational biology, bioinformatics, and applications.

Proceedings of BSB 2008 will be published by Springer as Lecture Notes in Bioinformatics. Selected papers will be invited to submit an extended version to the periodic Computers in Biology and Medicine, published by Elsevier.

BSB will have eleven lectures of various themes, and will have five foreign speakers. Four of these lectures will be joint to EBB (The First Brazilian School on Bioinformatics).
